

- 1. Enter the first few letters of the prospect's medication to determine if there is a PAP program for that medication. If the medication is found in the drop-down, a PAP program is available. If not, there are no current programs for that medication.
- 2. If there is a program, your team member completes and submits the simple form with the prospect online. We do the rest, from contacting the prospect to handling the entire approval process for them.
- 3. If the prospect has any questions or is not prepared to submit the form, the site provides easy-to-read information about prescription assistance programs along with FAQ's. If a prospect is still not ready to sign, you can share the site with them to complete the process with the same ease.


Deal Options for Affiliates
